# AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH OF DUMONT TAX COLLECTOR TO PREPARE AND MAIL ESTIMATED TAX BILLS IN ACCORDNACE WITH P.L. 1994, C. 72

WHEREAS, the Borough of Dumont's 2023 Municipal Budget has not been adopted and the County of Bergen is unable to certify the Borough's current 2023 tax rate; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Collector will be unable to mail the Borough's 2023 tax bills on a timely basis; and

WHEREAS, the Dumont Tax Collector in consultation with the Dumont Chief Financial Officer has computed an estimated tax levy in accordance with N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.3, and they have both signed a certification summarizing the tax levies for the previous year, the tax rates and the estimated tax levies for the 2023 calendar year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Dumont, in the County of Bergen and State of New Jersey on this 16th day of May, 2023 as follows:

- 1. The Borough of Dumont Tax Collector is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and issue estimated tax bills for the Borough for the third installment of 2023 taxes. The Tax Collector shall proceed and take such actions as are permitted and required by L. 1994, c.72 (N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.2 and 54.4-66.3).
- 2. The estimated calendar year tax levy for 2023 is hereby calculated at \$66,770,103. The maximum amount that the Borough will utilize in the preparation of the 2023 estimated tax bills is less than 105% of the 2022 calendar year tax levy.
- 3. In accordance with New Jersey Statutes, the third installment of 2023 taxes shall not be subject to interest until the later of August 10<sup>th</sup> or the twenty-fifth calendar day after the date the estimated tax bills were mailed. The estimated tax bills shall contain a notice specifying the date on which interest may begin to accrue.

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# GRANT PERMISSION AND SET FORTH CONDITIONS FOR TABLE TURN TV INC. FILMING PERMIT

- 6. That at least two weeks in advance of the first scheduled filming date, the Applicant shall provide written notification to each business owner/homeowner/occupant on the streets where filming is taking place, as well as sending such written notification to the neighbors abutting those streets. A copy of the letter shall be provided to the Office of the Municipal Clerk.
- 7. All noise generated during filming shall be kept at a minimum, realizing that the filming is taking place in residential areas.
- 8. All vehicles associated with the filming shall follow all parking rules and parking vehicles shall be as directed by the Police Department so as to allow emergency vehicles to pass through if necessary.
- 9. Removal of any trash generated by the filming event shall be the responsibility of the Applicant.
- 10. That use of private property during filming requires a separate contractual or insurance relationship between the applicant and the property owner for which the Borough has no responsibility.
- 11. That at least two weeks before the first scheduled filming date, emergency contact information, including name, and mobile phone number, of those on film location and in charge during the filming event be provided to the Office of the Municipal Clerk and to the Chief of Police for emergency contact purposes.
- 12. All fees as set forth in Chapter 213-12 of the Dumont Borough Code shall be paid prior to the commencement of filming.

# RESOLUTION SUPPORTING S3739/A5402 DELAYING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FOURTH ROUND OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING OBLIGATIONS

Jeanine E. Siek, RMC, Municipal Clerk Borough of Dumont, Bergen County, New Jersey

WHEREAS, the Borough of Dumont endorses Bill S3739/A5402 preserving the currently established 3rd round obligations for an additional three years by legislating a pause in determining 4th round Affordable Housing obligations, including present and prospective need and related litigation, which is scheduled to commence in July of 2025; and,

**WHEREAS**, this would give all parties additional time to assess the efficacy and local impacts on the 3rd round agreements and give the legislature and the Governor time to reestablish their proper roles in balancing the needs of all stakeholders in this process; and,

WHEREAS, New Jersey's municipalities working through the 3rd round obligations require more time than had been allotted given the cascading effects of Covid; and,

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WHEREAS, municipalities are still sorting out the ripple effects of Covid lockdowns on their tax base and land use plans; and,

WHEREAS, many builders are demanding more residential units than the infrastructure of our fully developed communities can safely and responsibly absorb faulting the post Covid record inflation that drives construction, debt financing and service costs to levels that incentivize builders to overreach; and,

WHEREAS, municipalities should be allowed to work towards appropriately meeting the 3<sup>rd</sup> round commitments before adding yet another layer that public health safety & welfare, limited infrastructure, hyper-local environmental and infrastructure challenges and fiscal realities may show to be unrealistic.

**NOW THEREFORE BEING RESOLVED,** the Borough of Dumont strongly endorses Bill S3739/A5402 and believes that extending our 3<sup>rd</sup> round obligation to 2028 will present a clearer picture of how each of the towns fared in meeting their goals and might also reveal the hyper-local environmental and infrastructure challenges each municipality is facing in achieving those goals; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that our municipality should be allowed to work towards appropriately meeting the 3rd round commitments, before adding yet another layer of unrealistic allocations - allocations that disregard the structural limitations costs and ancillary impacts on our already overburdened taxpayers; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Governor Murphy; the members of the NJ Senate and Assembly representing Dumont; the League of Municipalities; and all Bergen County Municipalities.
