

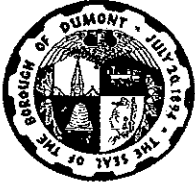
**SHUSHKO-APPROVAL OF 100% TAX EXEMPTION**

**THIRD QUARTER TAX GRACE PERIOD EXTENSION**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:4-67 permits the Mayor and Council of each municipality to fix the rate of interest to be charged for the nonpayment of taxes on or before the date when they would become delinquent; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Dumont, set forth said interest rate by Resolution #27 at their January 6, 2015 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Dumont was unable to mail its 2015/2016 property tax bills on or before June 14 as required by N.J.S.A. 54:4-66.2 due to the failure on the part of the State of New Jersey to certify state aid funding in a timely manner to permit the Bergen County Board of

Taxation to certify the 2015 municipal tax rate and apportionment of taxes; and

**WHEREAS**, this delay will result in the late mailing of the 2015/2016 tax bills to Borough property owners;

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Dumont, County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, that the interest rate for the nonpayment of 3rd quarter 2015 property taxes shall be fixed at zero (0%) percent until September 4, 2015.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that if payment of the 3rd quarter 2015 property tax is not made on or before September 4, 2015, the time period set forth above, then the interest rate for nonpayment of the 3rd quarter 2015 property tax shall revert back to the original interest rate established in Resolution #27 and shall be charged from the statutory payment date for 3rd quarter property taxes of August 1, 2015.

**WHEREAS**, the Local Finance Board has promulgated N.J.A.C. 5:30-6.5, a regulation requiring that the governing body of each municipality shall, by resolution, certify to the Local Finance Board of the State of New Jersey that all members of the Governing Body have reviewed, at a minimum, the sections of the annual audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, the members of the Governing Body have personally reviewed, at a minimum, the Annual Report of Audit, and specifically the sections of the Annual Audit entitled "Comments and Recommendations", as evidenced by the group affidavit form of the Governing Body attached hereto; and
