## RESOLUTION OF THE DUMONT BOROUGH COUNCIL TO RATIFY AND IMPLEMENT AN AMENDED HOUSING ELEMENT AND FAIR SHARE PLAN IF APPROVED AND ENDORSED BY THE COURT

Borough of Dumont, Bergen County, New Jersey

WHEREAS, the Borough of Dumont and the Dumont Planning Board n/k/a the Dumont Joint Land Use Board, are engaged in certain litigation entitled <u>Landmark Dumont</u>, <u>LLC v. Borough of Dumont</u>, et als., docket number BER-L-1297-14, seeking builder's remedy and Mount Laurel related relief; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is also engaged in a simultaneous, consolidated Declaratory Judgment action, bearing docket number BER-L-6065-15, seeking a Judgment of Compliance

with constitutional and statutory affordable housing mandates; and

WHEREAS, a settlement agreement was adopted and authorized for execution by the Borough Council on March 8, 2016, and has been executed by the Borough and the Plaintiff, Landmark Dumont, LLC; and

WHEREAS, a motion for a fairness hearing has been made to the court, returnable on May 12, 2016, seeking approval of the settlement and for a partial judgment of compliance and unlimited, temporary immunity from further suit pending final 3<sup>rd</sup> round compliance, which includes approval of an amended Housing Element and Fair Share Plan (HEFSP) consistent with the settlement agreement; and

WHEREAS, a revised, draft HEFSP has been prepared by Maser Consulting, the Borough's and Board's professional planner for consideration by the Court and presented to the Governing Body and Board for explanation and comment, and upon proper public notice, a hearing was held; and

WHEREAS, the Court requires, in order to consider the settlement agreement and HEFSP that the Borough and Board accept and agree to adopt, ratify and implement the HEFSP and Master Plan amendment.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the Borough of Dumont, Bergen County, State of New Jersey, hereby accepts the Housing Element and Fair Share Plan as presented, or as legally required to be amended for compliance, and agrees to endorse and implement same if and when approved by the Court and adopted by the Borough of Dumont Planning Board/Joint Land Use Board; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that a copy of this resolution shall be served upon all parties to the Litigation, including the Service List on the Declaratory Judgment action referenced above and upon the Municipal Clerks of each municipality bordering the Borough of Dumont upon adoption and execution hereof.
