

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, copies of this resolution shall be provided to T&M, Borough Auditor and the CFO.



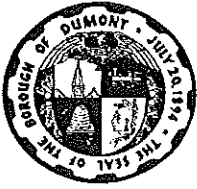
