

## **NWS issues Ice Storm Warning for Bergen County**

The Ice Storm Warning is in effect until 6 PM Wednesday (2/2). The Winter Storm Warning has been cancelled.

Current predictions call for snow and sleet this afternoon with accumulations of 3-5" and trace ice accumulations possible.

Overnight, freezing drizzle and light sleet starting this evening changing to freezing rain and sleet after midnight is predicted. Additional sleet accumulation of around an inch anticipated. A high of 31° with a low of 27° is predicted.

Wednesday (2/2): Freezing rain and sleet are predicted before noon changing over to rain and sleet in the afternoon. Total ice accumulations of one-quarter to one-half inch are possible. A high of 34° with a low of 25° is predicted. Total snow/sleet accumulation is predicted to be 6 to 10 inches.

The potential for ice accumulation may make travel hazardous. Additionally, the potential for tree limbs and power line issues exist.
