WHEREAS, it is indeed significant when one of our citizens has the unique perspective of viewing our community for over sixty years, and

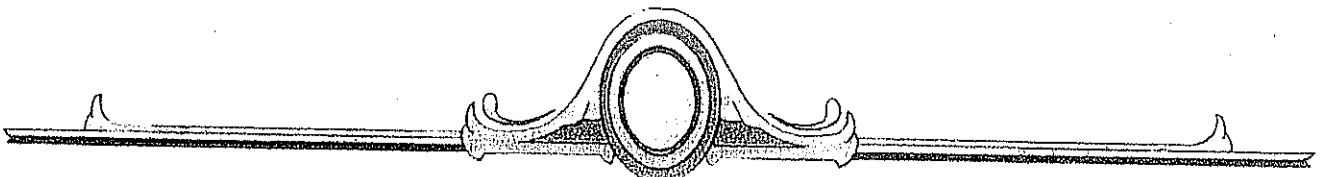
WHEREAS, within that timespan, great changes have taken place in the Borough of Dumont and Louis has been here for this immense transformation;

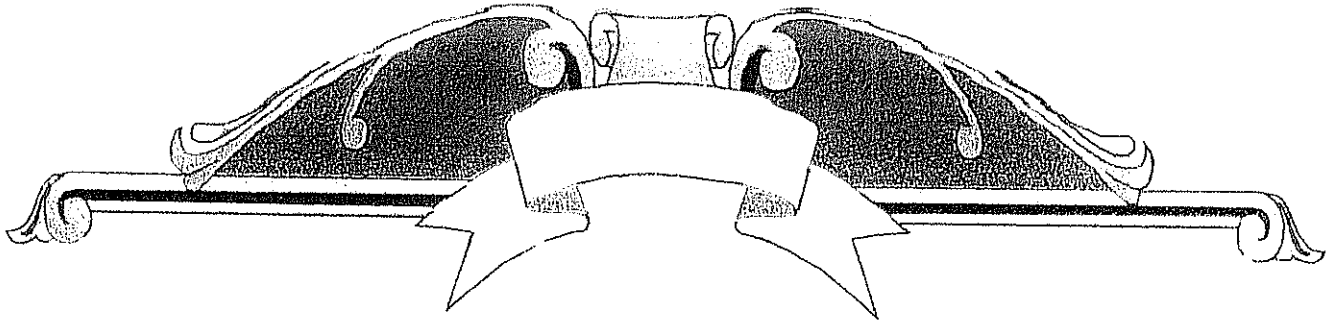
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that I, Matthew P. McHale, do hereby proclaim November 14, 2008 as:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Dumont recognizes the contribution of senior citizens to our community and the important role they serve in our society; and


