**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BOROUGH CODE CHAPTER 75 - PROVISIONS
SETTING FORTH THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TABLE OF ORGANIZATION AND
PROMOTIONAL PROCEDURES**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Dumont (“Borough”) has determined that changes to the Borough Code concerning the Police Department Table of Organization and the duration of promotional eligibility lists for Sergeant, Lieutenant and Captain are required to ensure efficient, orderly and effective operation of the Borough’s Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that it is in the best interests of the Borough and members of the Police Department to update the Table of Organization and to increase the duration of promotional eligibility lists for Sergeant, Lieutenant and Captain;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Dumont, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Section 75-2 of the Borough Code be and is hereby amended to read [amendments are in **bold**] as follows:

- A. Department Positions
- (b) **Up to two Captains;**
- (c) **Up to five Lieutenants;**
- (d) **Up to seven Sergeants;**
- (e) **Up to twenty-two police officers.**

2. Section 75-9 of the Borough Code be and is hereby amended to read [amendments are in **bold**] as follows:

- A. Promotion to Sergeant, Lieutenant and Captain.

(3) Each list of eligibles shall be certified by the Mayor and Council, or their designee, and shall remain in effect for a period of twenty-four months from the date it is finalized. **The Mayor and Council may, at their sole discretion, by Resolution, extend the duration of any list of eligibles for an additional one month.** Any list of eligibles in effect as of the effective date of this Ordinance shall remain valid for **twenty-five months** from its **date of finalization.**

3. Repealer

All Ordinances and parts thereof conflicting herewith be, and the same hereby are, repealed.

4. Severability

If any section, paragraph subdivision, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to that section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be valid and effective.

5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as required by law.
