**UTILIZATION OF THREE-YEAR AVERAGE METHOD TO CALCULATE THE
MAXIMUM MISCELLANEOUS REVENUES**

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic had an adverse effect on certain anticipated municipal revenues in the 2020 current fund budget; and

WHEREAS, Section 1 of P.L. 2020, c.74 amended N.J.S.A 40A:4-26 authorized the Director of the Division of Local Government Services ("Division") to promulgate new standards for the anticipation of COVID-19 affected revenues in the 2021 budget; and

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey, Department of Community Affairs, Division of Local Government Services requires a resolution by Municipalities that desire to utilize a three-year average to determine the maximum amount of revenue permitted to be anticipated in the annual budget as otherwise provided under NJSA 40A:4-26; and

WHEREAS, the Borough realized certain revenue shortfalls during 2020 as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body has determined it is beneficial for the Borough to utilize a three-year average of revenues to be anticipated in the 2021 budget for Municipal Court Fines and Costs, Uniform Construction Code Fees and Other Fees and Permits; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Dumont, County of Bergen and State of New Jersey, that the Borough Council approves the utilization of the three-year average method for the following revenues to be anticipated in the 2021 budget:



WHEREAS, the Borough and the affected officers have determined, to their mutual satisfaction, the amounts to be paid to each officer.


BE IT RESOLVED, the Borough shall reimburse the affected officers as follows:




